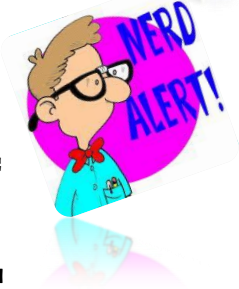
News You Can Use

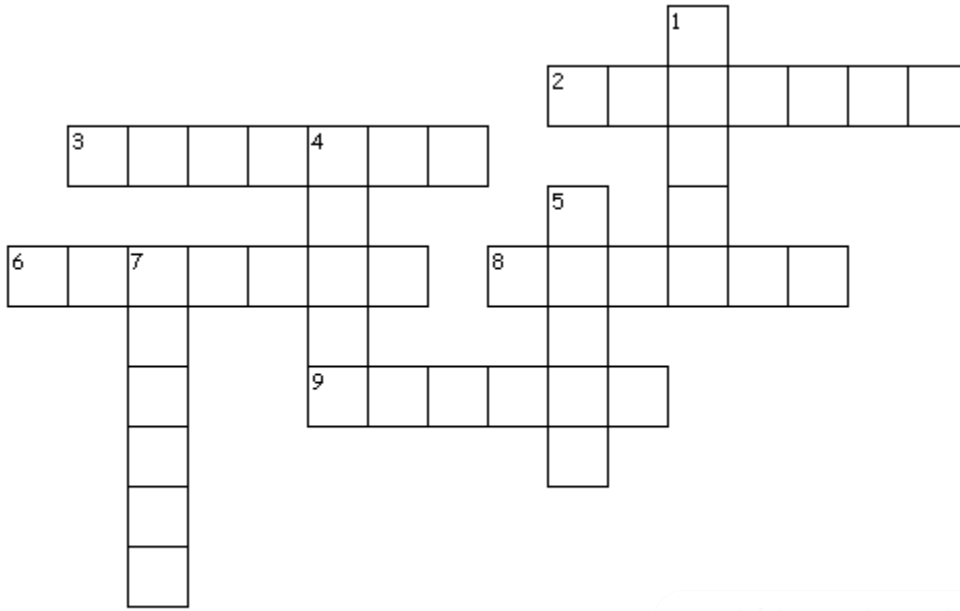
